Your information

Your information is collected by healthcare providers so they can provide you with appropriate care and plan the health services you need.

Sharing information between your healthcare providers means they all have access to up to date information to make a better informed decision, giving you the best care possible as quickly as possible.

CareConnect TestSafe

CareConnect TestSafe is an electronic database that allows those involved in your care to access and share selected information such as test results and medications dispensed.

Your choice

If you don't wish other healthcare providers to see your information in CareConnect TestSafe, you can stop the sharing of your information by phoning 0508 CARE CONNECT (0508 227 326) or by telling your healthcare provider when a test is ordered, or pharmacist when medication is dispensed.

If you choose to prevent access to your information your treatment may be delayed, for example while tests are repeated or pharmacists confirm what medications you have been dispensed previously.
